The Applegate project has created an attractive approach to Wygston's House (a 15th Century timber framed building) and forms part of the pedestrian friendly route that Leicester City Council is creating to better link its many heritage attractions.

Quality materials, including natural stone granite, dark concrete blocks & some of the streets existing cobbles were re-used in the scheme.

Larsen's BS 7533 compliant paving mortar system was chosen to bed, prime & grout all three types of specified paving.
